SANCTION POLICY
Adopted February 2009

Purpose:

- To ensure quality competitions are hosted in Manitoba with proper medical service
- To ensure each club has the opportunity to host 2 competitions annually

Scope and Application:

- The policy applies to all Boxing Manitoba affiliated competitive clubs, each who may (as the schedule warrants) sanction up to 3 events annually
- First consideration will be given, to ensure all clubs are able to host 2 competitions annually if they choose.
- No more than 3 competitions will be sanctioned in any given month

Application

- Sanction application must be accompanied by the applicable sanction fee
- Clubs will be notified in writing that the event has been sanctioned when medical services and officials have been confirmed.

Approved Sanctions

- All sanctioned events MUST have a minimum of 4 confirmed real bouts (no exhibitions or sparring sessions) A list of these bouts must be submitted to the Chief Official through the Boxing Manitoba office a minimum of 7 days prior to the competition.
- Clubs may cancel a sanctioned event up to 4 pm five (5) days prior to the competition date with no financial ramifications. The sanction fee will be returned to the club.
- Failure to submit a list of 4 confirmed bouts OR events without 4 confirmed bouts will be canceled by the Chief Official and the sanction fee will be forfeit
- Clubs cancelling after the 4pm five (5) days prior to competition will forfeit the sanction fee
- Clubs cancelling within three days of the competition date will forfeit the sanction fee and be charged the doctors fee (\$ 250 in 2009)
